Mrs. Alice King Harrison, age 94, of Forrest City, died Sunday at her home in Forrest City. She had been in poor health for the past several months.

Mrs. Harrison was born May 2, 1920, in Forrest City at the home of her grandparents, the home she has lived in for the past forty-five years. She was the daughter of the late Mrs. Mattie Mann King and the late Mr. Benjamin Franklin King.

Mrs. Harrison graduated from Sweet Briar College in Virginia, worked as a mathematician at Langley Field, Virginia, and later worked at the aeronautical engine research lab in Cleveland, Ohio. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church, the Garden Gate Garden Club, Musical Coterie, Junior Auxiliary, Cosmos Club, and the General Federation Women's Club. She was treasurer of the Forrest City Library for thirty-five years, was president of the American Cancer Society in Forrest City, had served thirty years for the Crowley Ridge Girl Scouts, and had served on the St. Francis County Museum Board.

Mrs. Harrison married Morris Harrison in 1948, and he preceded her in death in 1980. She is survived by three daughters; Letitia Harrison Varner of Sherwood, Arkansas, Mary Harrison Clark of Forrest City, and Frances Harrison Weaver of Morehead, Kentucky, eight grandchildren; Allison, Amanda, Michael, Matthew, Melissa, Virginia, Harrison, and Alice, and eight great-grandchildren. She had one brother, Benjamin Franklin King Jr., who preceded her in death in 1943.

Services for Mrs. Harrison will be held Graveside, 10:00 A.M., Monday, at the Forrest Park Cemetery. Visitation will be Sunday evening, 6:00 P.M.
