Amy Michelle Cox Gammill, age 47, of Hot Springs, died Friday, December 18, 2020, at her home in Hot Springs. Her death came sudden and unexpected.

Amy was born November 29, 1973, in West Memphis, Arkansas, and was the daughter of Phillip Cox and Kay Hill Cox. She moved to Hot Springs from Jonesboro in 2016, was a R.N.C. for the National Park Medical Center in Hot Springs, and was a member of the First Baptist Church in Hot Springs.

My sweet Amy Cox Gammill has stepped into heaven to be with her Lord and savior Jesus Christ. She worked nights for so many years so she could be with her babies. And they are better for it. She was working hard to complete her doctorate in nursing. Maybe too hard. Upon

finding her this morning I'm not sure what happened, but my hope is in Jesus Christ. I know she is with him and I will see her again. Please pray for God's peace and comfort for my kids and my precious in-laws, Phil and Kay Cox, who lost their other daughter, Emily, when Amy was in high school.

Amy married Dustan Gammill in 1994, and he survives her along with three sons; Jonathan Luke Gammill of Jonesboro, Benjamin David Gammill and Eli Jacob Gammill, both of the home, one daughter, Emily Faith Gammill of the home, and her parents; Phil and Kay Cox of Forrest City. She had one sister, Emily Rose Cox, who preceded her in death in 1991.

Services for Mrs. Gammill will be held at First Baptist Church in Forrest City, 11:00 A.M., Tuesday, with burial in Mt. Vernon Cemetery. 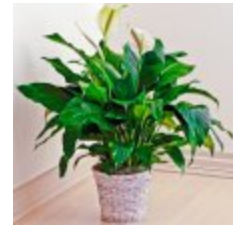

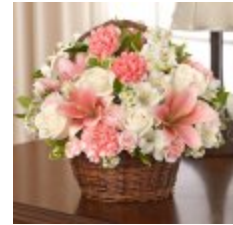
