Mr. Archie Wade Ford age 92, of Forrest City, Arkansas died Saturday, Dec. 29, at the Forrest City Medical Center.

Mr. Ford was born Sept.28, 1915, in Des Arc, Arkansas. He was the son of James Ford and Fleetie Stanley Ford. Mr. Ford lived in Forrest City all of his life where he had worked at the Ford Food Center and the First National Bank, both for several years. He was a member of the First Baptist Church and was the oldest living male member. Mr. Ford was very fond of woodworking and was a Veteran of World War II.

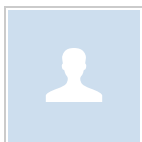
