Arturo Cesar 'Art' Rendon Sr., age 53, of Forrest City, died Monday, April 13, 2026, at the Forrest City Medical Center in Forrest City. His death came sudden and unexpected.

Mr. Rendon was born December 22, 1972, in Sinton, Texas, and was the son of Gilbert Rendon and Rosa Rosenbaum Rendon. He lived in St. Francis County most of his life, was a Correctional Counselor for the Forrest City Federal Prison, and was a member of the Ridgewood Baptist Church.
