June 24, 1930 - March 13, 2025

Audrey Barton Pearson, age 94, of Forrest City, died March 13, 2025, at her home in Forrest City.

Mrs. Pearson was born June 24, 1930, in Selma, Arkansas, and was the daughter of T. T. Barton and Irma Barrett Barton. Audrey graduated from DeValls Bluff High School, where she was Salutatorian of her senior class and an All-District basketball player. After graduation, she moved to Forrest City and lived there for the remainder of her life.

Audrey was retired from the Forrest City School District, where she was District Treasurer and Manager of the Superintendent's office. She served under four different Superintendents: Bill Irving, Walter Gene Prewett, James Laws, and Emmerson Hall.

In her earlier years she was an avid golfer. One of her greatest joys was playing golf with her three young grandsons; first with Chance and later with Jackson and Johnathan. She was an associate member of the Garden Gate Garden Club and was a member of the Episcopal Church of the Good Shepherd, where she was a longtime member of the Altar Guild.

Audrey married James Allen Pearson Jr., and he preceded her in death after fifty-two years of marriage. She dearly loved her family and is survived by her
