



Billy Huddleston

December 27, 1934 - January 4, 2010

Mr. Billy Gene Huddleston, age 75, of Forrest City, died Monday at the Newport Health Care and Rehabilitation Center in Newport. He had been in poor health for the past four years.

Mr. Huddleston was born December 27, 1934, in Holcomb, Missouri, and was the son of Charles Huddleston and Opal McLeskey Huddleston. He lived in Missouri before moving to Forrest City in 1971, was a past employee for Massey Ferguson, retired from Farm Bureau in 2001, was a Korean Veteran, and was a member of the First Baptist Church in Forrest City.

Mr. Huddleston married Beth Cassidy in 1953, and she survives him along with two sons; James C. Huddleston of Newport, and Rob Huddleston of Forrest City, two sisters; Barbara Murdock of Holcomb, Missouri, and Charlotte Howlett of Bragg City, Missouri, five grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. He had two grandchildren, Robert Huddleston and Billy Huddleston, who both preceded him in death.
