Billy Joe Pillow, age 70, of Forrest City, died Saturday at his home in Forrest City. His death came sudden and unexpected.

Mr. Pillow was born July 29, 1948, in Hughes, Arkansas, and was the son of John Edward Pillow Sr. and Mary Ruth Burrow Pillow. He lived in St. Francis County most all of his life, was retired from Sanyo, and was a member of the Good Hope Baptist Church.
