Mrs. Bobbie Linderman, age 73, of Forrest City, died Saturday at her home in Forrest City. She had been in poor health for the past several weeks.

Mrs. Linderman was born February 3, 1944, in Waynesboro, Tennessee, and was the daughter of Boyd Matney and Edna Jackson Matney.
