



Mr. Bobby Ward McNair

November 20, 1954 - November 25, 2019

Bobby Ward McNair, age 65, of Widener, died Monday, November 25, 2019, at the Methodist University Hospital in Memphis. He had been in poor health for the past several months.

Mr. McNair was born November 20, 1954 in Forrest City and was the son of William Ward McNair and Mattie Davis McNair. He grew up in the Newcastle community and moved to the Widener area in 1976.
