Bonnie could cook and bake delicious meals and desserts, and her homemade rolls were divine. She loved her family and friends and will be dearly missed by all.

Mrs. Byrd married Carl Clarkson, and he preceded her in death in 1978. She is survived by two sons; Doug Clarkson, and wife, Jane, of Wynne, and Allen Clarkson, and wife, Jedonne, of Palestine, seven grandchildren and several great-grandchildren. She had one daughter, Rhonda Clarkson and one son,

Scott Clarkson, who preceded her in death.

Mrs. Byrd married A.D. Byrd, and he survives her along with one step-son, David Byrd, one step-daughter, Cindy Lower, and husband, Keith, all of Rogers, Arkansas, several step-grandchildren and step-great-grandchildren.
