Mr. Brad Hudspeth, age 56, died Sunday at the Baptist Hospital in Memphis. He had been in poor health for the past two months.

Mr. Hudspeth was born August 20, 1959, in Forrest City, and was the son of Lewis 'Leggs' Hudspeth and Kathryn V. Jones Hudspeth. He lived in St. Francis County most all of his life, was a rural mail carrier in Hughes, Arkansas, for the past seventeen years, was a member of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church in Palestine and served on the Church Mission Committee.

He was an A.A.A. and N.C.A.A. Official. He was a member of the Arkansas Officials Association. He officiated high school football and baseball from 1985 to 2015, the Arkansas Activities Association Championship Games, Football, 1995,1999,2001,2004 and 2008, Baseball, 1994,2003,2006, Arkansas Activities Association All-Star Game, Football 1997, Baseball 2006, College, Gulf South, 1994 thru 2011, Great American Conference, 2011 thru 2015, and Division II Play-off, 1998,2001,2010, and officiated in the National Football

League in 2012.

Mr. Hudspeth is survived by two brothers; Barton Hudspeth of Palestine and Robert Hudspeth, and wife, Debbie, of St. Louis, Missouri, one nephew, Justin Hudspeth, one niece, Courtney H. Hudspeth, both of St. Louis, a host of other relatives and friends and many good friends in the Hughes area.
