



Burl H. Downey

November 28, 1927 - December 11, 2016

Mr. Burl H. Downey, age 89, of Cabot, formerly of Forrest City, died Sunday at the Cabot Health and Rehab in Cabot. He had been in poor health for the past two months.

Mr. Downey was born November 28, 1927, in Caldwell, and was the son of Albert A. Downey and Bertha Brents Downey. He lived in St. Francis County most of his life, was an automotive instructor for Crowley's Ridge Vo-Tech, was a Veteran of World War II, was a Mason, and a member of the Light House Ministries Church.

Mr. Downey married Louella Bowman in 1950, and she preceded him in death in 2005. He is survived by two sons; Everett Downey of Manchester, New Hampshire and David Downey of Cabot, one brother, James Downey of Forrest City, three sisters; Gladys Hopkins of Kansas City, Kansas, Geneva Haycraft and Lillian Garner, both of Forrest City, five grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. He had one brother, Calvin Downey, who preceded him in death.
