Mr. Burl William Lieblong, age 74, of Forrest City, died Friday at his home in Forrest City.

Mr. Lieblong was born June 9, 1941, in Memphis, and was the son of Luther James 'Luke' Lieblong and Corinne Harris Lieblong. He lived in St. Francis County all of his life, retired President of the Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute in Forrest City, and was a member of the United Methodist Church.

Mr. Lieblong married Joann Robinson in 1991, and she survives him along with four sons; Andy Lieblong and Ryan Robb, both of Forrest City, Kevin Robb of Marion, and Jeremy Robb of Palestine, two daughters; Margo McElroy and Leslye Laws, both of Forrest City, one brother, Luther Lieblong of Forrest City, one sister, Alice Simmons of Batesville, nine grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

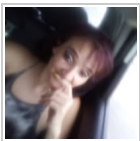
