March 21, 1991 - April 8, 2013

Mr. Caleb Sean Haydar, age 22, of Forrest City, died Monday at the Regional Medical Center in Memphis. His death came sudden and unexpected.

Mr. Haydar was born March 21, 1991, in Memphis, Tennessee, and was the son of Najmi Haydar and Stacy Alford Kilgore. He lived most of his life in Forrest City, was a technician for Honda of Forrest City, and attended the Smith Chapel Baptist Church.
