Charles R. Adamson, age 92, of Forrest City, died Wednesday, September 11, 2024, at the St. Francis Hospital-Bartlett, in Bartlett, Tennessee. He had been in poor health for the past several years and in the hospital for the past five days.

Mr. Adamson was born April 22, 1932, in Forrest City, and was the son of George David Adamson and Lucille Browning Adamson. He lived in St. Francis County all of his life, was a mechanic and retired from the Forrest City High School where he taught auto mechanics, was a farmer and a cattleman. He was a past director of Farm Bureau, a member of the East Arkansas Cattleman's Association, and had attended the Hope and Trust Missionary Baptist Church.

Mr. Adamson married Ruby Miller in 1949, and she survives him along with two sons; Jerry Adamson, and wife, Joanne, of San Antonio, Texas, and David Adamson, and wife, Rosetta Coleman, of Forrest City, one brother, Bob Adamson, and wife, Judy, of Palestine, one sister-in-law, Gladys Adamson of Des Arc, five grandchildren and twelve great-grandchildren. He had one brother, Jack Adamson, one sister, Billie Jean Huffman, who preceded him in death.
