Mr. Charles D. Lawson, age 98, of Forrest City, died Sunday at the River Ridge Nursing Home in Wynne. He had been in poor health for the past month.

Mr. Lawson was born September 7, 1918, in Chickasaw County, Mississippi, and was the son of Mira Lawson and Ella Mae Allen Lawson. He lived in Forrest City most of his life, was retired from Eaton Corporation, was a Veteran of World War II, and attended the Church of Christ.
