



## Charles Randall 'Randy' Watson

December 27, 1956 - November 30, 2019

Charles Randall 'Randy' Watson, age 62, of Forrest City, died Saturday, November 30, 2019, at the Willowbend Healthcare & Rehabilitation, in Marion. His death came sudden and unexpected.
