



Bishop Chelch E. Reagan

July 4, 1944 - June 8, 2025

Bishop Chelch E. Reagan, age 80, of Caldwell, died Sunday, June 8, 2025, at the CrossRidge Hospital in Wynne. He had been in poor health for the past several years.

Chelch was born July 4, 1944, in Birmingham, Alabama, and was the son of Joe Reagan and Ellie Hicks Reagan. He was a minister for fifty years and was a devoted Pastor of the Forrest City Church of God until his retirement.

Chelch married Dixie Evans in 1962, and she survives him along with one son, Ronald Reagan of Caldwell, one daughter, Shelia Reagan Lieblong, and husband, Andy, of Forrest City, one brother, Ronald Reagan of Louisiana, one sister, Diane Stewart of Louisiana, two grandchildren; Nicole Lieblong Higgins and Ryan Phillip Reagan, and six great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by one granddaughter, Chelsea Reagan, two brothers, and three sisters.
