July 21, 1952 - October 1, 2019

Christopher Charles Quinn, age 67, of Forrest City, died Tuesday, October 1, 2019, at the Forrest City Medical Center. His death came sudden and unexpected.

Mr. Quinn was born July 21, 1952, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and was the son of Thomas Charles Quinn Jr. and Oneta Queen Quinn. He lived in Forrest City since 1976, was the former owner of McDonalds, a Veteran of the Army, a volunteer fireman, and was a member of the First Baptist Church in Forrest City.

Mr. Quinn married Ginger Garey Clay in 1989, and she survives him along with three daughters; Carey McDaniel, and husband, Brian, of Forrest City, Cathryn Peeler of Jonesboro, and Claudia McCutchen, and husband, Thomas, of Wynne, four sisters; Cindy Mulick of Branson, Missouri, Connie Bitney of Conrad, Montana, Carolyn Hammer of Forrest City, and Celia Montgomery of Hope, Arkansas, and seven grandchildren; Alexis, Adalee, Tacker, Ella Cate, Ashlyn, Clayton, and Emerson. He was preceded in death by one sister, Cheryl Izatt, one son-in-law, Jared Peeler, and two nieces, Jennifer and Ashley Hammer.
