February 5, 1946 - February 3, 2011

Mr. Dana C. Baker, age 64, of Forrest City, died Thursday at the Forrest City Medical Center in Forrest City. His death came suddenly and unexpectedly.

Mr. Baker was born February 5, 1946, in Nancy, Kentucky, and was the son of Cecil Baker and Marie Trimble Baker. He moved to Forrest City in 1980 from Kentucky, was a Veteran of the Navy, was an employee of the Forrest City Housing Authority, and was a member of the First Baptist Church in Madison.

Mr. Baker married Lucile Kennedy in 1979, and she survives him along with his father, Cecil Baker of Nancy, Kentucky, one brother, Roy Lee Baker of Nancy, Kentucky, and two grandchildren; Holden Raines and Rebekah Moore. He had one step-daughter, Tonya Moore, who preceded him in death.
