Dana Glae Dawson Whittington, age 80, of Forrest City, died Tuesday, November 12, 2019. She had been in poor health for the past year and a half.

Mrs. Whittington was born July 10, 1939, in Altus, Arkansas, and was the daughter of Milton Dawson and Hazel Hall Dawson. She was an identical twin to Jane Marie Dawson.
