Darlene Levitt Miller, age 80, of Forrest City, died Monday, August, 15, 2022, at the River Ridge Rehab and Care Center in Wynne. She had been in poor health for the past six months.

Mrs. Miller was born December 30, 1941, in Palestine, and was the daughter of George Levitt and Gladys Thigpen Levitt. She lived in St. Francis County most all of her life, graduated from Wheatley High School in 1959, was retired from the First National Bank of Eastern Arkansas after twenty-five years of service, and was a member of the First Baptist Church of Caldwell.

Mrs. Miller married David L. Miller in 1962, and he survives her along with one son, Mark L. Miller, and wife, Lisa, of Forrest City, one daughter, Kim Moody, and husband, Chuck, of Ward, Arkansas, seven grandchildren; Cassie Miller, Kyle Miller, and wife, Halie, Matthew Miller, and wife, Elizabeth, Mallory Jones, and husband, Blake, Mica Hurt, Macey Hurt, Tyler Moody, and wife, Lacey, two great-granddaughters; Leah Miller and Raegan Lynn Miller, one brother, Arley Levitt of Bartlett, Tennessee, and one sister-in-law, Virginia Levitt of Pickens, South Carolina. She had two brothers; James Levitt and Wayne Levitt, who preceded her in death.
