Mr. Donald Ray Cagle, age 65, of Palestine, died Monday at the U.A.M.S. Hospital in Little Rock. He had been in poor health for the past four months.

Mr. Cagle was born December 16, 1944, in Palestine, and was the son of Albert Cagle and Hazel Johns Cagle Deaviser. 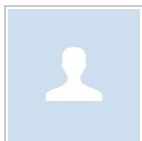
