Mr. Dwayne Couchman, age 83, of Forrest City, died Sunday at his home in Forrest City.

Mr. Couchman was born August 1, 1933, in Nettleton, Arkansas, and was the son of Herchalle Jacob Couchman and Effie Imogene Slaughter Couchman. 
