Emma Jean Sackville, age 82, of Wynne, formerly of Forrest City, died Sunday, July 9, 2023, at her home in Wynne. She had been in poor health for the past two weeks.

Mrs. Sackville was born November 16, 1940, in New Albany, Mississippi, and was the daughter of Dee Miller and Gera Dye Miller. She lived in St. Francis County most of her life, was a retired bookkeeper for the Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute, and was a member of the Colt Baptist Church.
