On March 18, 2024, Mrs. Esther Marie McCullar Chapman, age 75, of Forrest City entered the place she has sang and taught about her entire life, Heaven. She was one of the most steadfast Christians you would ever meet. Even through her many earthly trials and sickness her faith never wavered. Raised in a Pentecostal home, she knew very well the power of the Holy Spirit. She was an avid Sunday school teacher and choir director. She sang with the voice of an angel.
