Foon Quong 'Frank' Chu, age 97, of Forrest City, Arkansas, died Friday, May 17, 2019, at the Baptist Hospital in Memphis, Tennessee.

Frank Chu was born in Havana, Illinois, and was the fourth child of Quong and Seid Chu. He married Lily in Helena, Arkansas, and they were married for seventy-eight years.

Surviving is his wife, Lily S.
