Frances 'Fran' Garrison Kirk Billingsley, age 83, of Forrest City, passed away, Saturday, October 14, 2023, in Forrest City. She was born to Orville and Frances Garrison, July 8, 1940, in Jacksonville, Florida. She was the oldest of five children.

After graduating from Andrew Jackson High School in 1959, Frances furthered her education at Florida Christian College in Temple Terrace, Florida. There she met her first husband, Albert Kirk III, and was blessed with three children.

Frances relocated to Forrest City, Arkansas, in 1974. Ten years later she earned her Associates Degree in Nursing from East Arkansas Community College. She began her nursing career at Baptist Hospital in Forrest City for two years then continued her career at the Arkansas Department of Health. Frances was a passionate public health nurse, Crittenden County Administrator and Breast Care Coordinator. She was deeply devoted to her patients and families she served for twenty-five years, retiring in 2011. She was a devoted member of the Church of Christ.

Frances is survived by one son, Steven Kirk, and wife, Debra, of Azel, Texas, two daughters; Lisa Kirk of Houlton, Maine, and Shannon Davis, and husband, Wane, of Wynne, ten grandchildren; Cassie, Kyle, Brittney, Morgan,
