Mrs. Geneva Casey, age 95, of Forrest City, died Tuesday, March 9, 2021. She had been in poor health for the past year and a half.

Mrs. Casey was born August 15, 1925, in St. Francis County, and was the daughter of George Washington Morrow Padgett and Emma Watts Padgett. She lived in St. Francis County all of her life, retired from General Industries, and was a Baptist.

After retirement she continued to work on the farm. Her cows were her babies. She loved nothing better than to be out in the pasture among them, especially when there were calves aplenty. All she had to do is call and they would come running. Crocheting and quilting filled her winter months when weather confined her to the house.
