March 26, 1982 - August 21, 2009

Gina Lynn Flowers, age 27, of Tucson, Arizona, formerly of Pine Tree, died Friday at her home in Tucson. Her death came sudden and unexpected.

Gina was born March 26, 1982, in Forrest City, and was the daughter of Jimmy Flowers and Deborah Hamm Flowers Criss. She had graduated in May from the Pima Community College in Tucson and had enrolled in the Northern Arizona University in Tucson to receive her teaching degree.
