Mrs. Grace Hoy, age 94, died Sunday December 25, 2011 at the Hillhaven Assisted Living, Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Adelphi, Maryland. She had required assisted living care for the past several years.

Mrs. Hoy was born December 12, 1917, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and was the daughter of Chew and Lum Shee How. She moved with her family to Bolivar County, Mississippi in 1925 and then to Memphis, Tennessee in 1937.
