Mr. H. M. "Buddy" Jayroe age 73, of Forrest City, Arkansas died Saturday, August 23, 2008 at his home.

Mr. Jayroe was born July 4, 1935 in Palestine, Arkansas. He was the son of Jerry Jayroe and Winnie Swenia Jayroe. He was a member of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church in Palestine.
