Mr. Hackler M. Hill, age 81, of Heber Springs, formerly of Forrest City, died Sunday at the Southridge Nursing Home in Heber Springs. He had been in poor health for the past two years.

Mr. Hill was born May 19, 1929, in Lee County and was the son of Ben Hill and Esther Hendrix Hill. He lived in Forrest City until moving to Heber Springs in 1995, was retired from Yale Industries, was a Veteran of the Marines, and was a member of the Sugarloaf Baptist Church in Heber Springs.
