Mr. Hobert Eugene Parker, age 82, of Forrest City, died Monday at the Regional Medical Center in Memphis.

Mr. Parker was born May 9, 1931, in Jonesboro, and was the son of Jack Amon Parker and Virginia 'Tommie' Rook Parker Young. He retired from the U.S. Air Force in 1971 as a CMSGT (Chief Master Sergeant), was a master electrician, and had also retired from Halstead Industries. He participated in the Paragould Children's Home, the Board of Families First, and was very active in the Prison Ministries. He was a member of the Lindauer Road Church of Christ.

Mr. Parker married Hazel Williams of Pine Bluff, in 1954, and she survives him along with one daughter, Carol Parker Williams of Wynne, one son, Bryan Parker, and wife, Kelley, of Jonesboro, one brother, Hugh Marion Parker, and wife, Frances, of Talladega, Alabama, and two grandchildren; Jade and Katelyn.

Services for Mr. Parker will be held at the Lindauer Road Church of Christ, 2:00 P.M., Thursday, with burial in Bell Cemetery in Palestine.
