J. D. Marris Jr., age 90, of Palestine, died Thursday, March 28, 2024, at the Alcoa Pines Health and Rehabilitation in Benton, Arkansas. He had been in poor health for the past six months.

Mr. Marris was born February 28, 1934, in Little Rock, and was the son of Jesse Dee Marris Sr. and Frances Melton Marris. He lived in St. Francis County most of his life, was a retired butcher for Kroger, was a Veteran of the Army National Guard, and was a member of the Emmanuel Baptist Church.

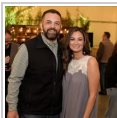

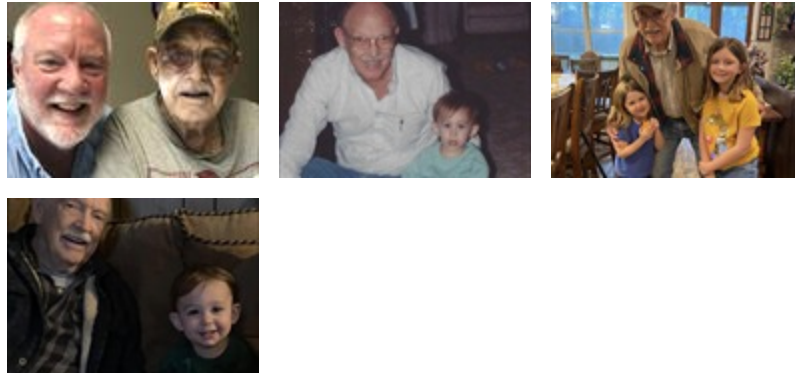
