Mr. James E. Fletcher, age 65, of Wynne, died Monday at the Forrest City Medical Center in Forrest City. His death came suddenly and unexpectedly.

Mr. Fletcher was born August 31, 1946, in Timbo, Arkansas, and was the son of Henry Fletcher and Dessie Branscum Fletcher. He lived in Wynne, Forrest City, and Marianna, most of his life, had worked for Yale Industries and had retired from Smith and Nephew in Memphis.
