Mr. James R. Nicks, age 75, of Forrest City, died Friday at the Baptist Hospital in Memphis.

Mr. Nicks was born September 28, 1932, in Haynes, and was the son of Willey B. Nicks and Mary Hazel Peacock Nicks. He lived in Moro and Haynes before moving to Forrest City.
