Jodie B. Cook Jr., age 83, of Forrest City, died Sunday, June 28, 2020, at his home in Forrest City. He had been in poor health for the past three months.

Mr. Cook was born January 26, 1937, in Madison, Arkansas, and was the son of Jodie B. Cook Sr. and Allie Bernice Shambley Cook. He lived in St. Francis County most all of his life, was a Veteran of the National Guard, was a master electrician, the President of the St. Francis Rural Water Association, and was the owner and manager of rental property in the area. He was a member of the Valley View Christian Church.
