



## John Wesley 'Bro Wes' Beavers

July 12, 1941 - September 18, 2022

John Wesley "Brother Wes" Beavers, age 81, of Forrest City, died Sunday, September 18, 2022, at the Baptist Hospital in Memphis. He had been in the hospital for the past three days.

Brother Wes was born July 12, 1941, in Trenton, Tennessee, and was the son of Dee Beavers and Helen Little Beavers. He was a Baptist minister and had served in Tennessee, Illinois, and Arkansas, before becoming the minister for Beck Spur Baptist Church in Forrest City in 1988. He received his degrees from the Mid-America Baptist Theological Seminary and the Bethany Divinity Seminary, and belonged to the Rock A Billy Hall of Fame.

Brother Wes married Annie Louise Fouch in 1961, and she survives him along with one son, Bart Beavers, and wife, Vicki, of Ripley, Tennessee, two daughters, Julie Anderson, and husband, Travis, of Forrest City, Cindy Davis, and husband, Shane, of Newbern, Tennessee, eleven grandchildren and fifteen great-grandchildren. He had one son, Clay Beavers, who preceded him in death in 2007.

Services for Brother Beavers will be held at the Beck Spur Baptist Church, 2:00 P.M., Wednesday, with burial in Forrest Park Cemetery. Visitation will be Wednesday, 1:00 P.M., until the time of the service, at the church. Stevens Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements. In lieu of flowers, memorials may
