John Preston Clark, age 83, of Wynne, formerly of Caldwell, passed away at his home surrounded by his family on Thursday, June 8, 2017.

Mr. Clark was born May 14, 1934. He was the second son of Hugh Moore Clark and Jimmie Marie Hughes Clark. He grew up in Caldwell, Arkansas, where he lived most of his life. In 1953, he graduated from Forrest City High School and was president of his senior class. He married Joyce Lindsey on October 29, 1955.

Mr. Clark joined the Army National Guard and spent time in Fort Chaffee, where he developed a deep love for his country. He joined his brother, Lewis, and became a partner in Clark's Super Service. They enjoyed a successful business until their retirement. He found great pleasure serving the community. Serving his friends was only surpassed by his love for his family. He was a faithful follower of Christ, served as Deacon at First Baptist Church of Caldwell, and was a Gideon.
