Mr. John B. Hess, age 85, of Forrest City, died Saturday at his home in Forrest City. His death came sudden and unexpected.

Mr. Hess was born February 20, 1932, in Texarkana, Arkansas, and was the son of Charles V. Hess and Mamie Dubois Hess. He lived in Forrest City most of his life, retired from the Union Pacific Railroad in 1990, and was a member of the Emmanuel Baptist Church.
