Johnie Faye Hurt, age 89, of Forrest City, went to her heavenly home, Tuesday, July 9, 2024, in Forrest City. Her passing came peacefully and unexpectedly.

Mrs. Hurt was born January 14, 1935, in Craighead County, Arkansas, and was the daughter of John L. Good and Sarah Nutt Good. She lived in Craighead County until moving to St. Francis County in 1952. She was a housewife and when she was in her fifties she went back to school and became an L.P.N. She went to work for Crestpark Nursing Home and had compassion and love for the elderly. She was a member of the Old Fashion Baptist Church in Palestine and later in life attended the Good Hope Baptist Church. She was very dedicated to working in the church nursery and was always helping in Vacation Bible School.

Mrs. Hurt married Ray Hurt Sr. in 1954, and he preceded her in death in 2002. She is survived by two daughters; Debbie Myers, and husband, Keith, of Forrest City and Madeline Parker, and husband, Randy, of Cave City. She was the eleventh child of twelve children and is survived by one sister, Sunshine Boles of Missouri, one brother, Carlyle Good of Florida, ten grandchildren, several great-grandchildren, and a host of nieces and nephews. She had one son, Ray Hurt Jr. who preceded her in death.
