



Jonathan Daniel Marotti

November 11, 1977 - May 7, 2021

Jonathan Daniel Marotti, age 43, died Friday, May 7, 2021, at his family's farm headquarters in Crawfordsville, AR. His death came suddenly and unexpectedly.

Mr. Marotti was born November 11, 1977, in Memphis, TN to Johnny and Sandra Chaney Marotti. He was the owner and operator of J & S Marotti Trucking, farm manager for Buckskin Farms, and founder of Grassy Lake Bottoms Duck Club in Crawfordsville, AR. He was a member of First Assembly of God in West Memphis, AR.

Mr. Marotti is survived by his parents; two sisters; Jenny Fraley of Marion, and Candice Carroll and husband Johnny of Crawfordsville; seven nieces and nephews; Amelia Fraley, Andrew Fraley, Levi Fraley, and Demi Fraley, all of Marion, and Chesleigh Gatgens, Johnny Carroll, and Julia Carroll, all of Crawfordsville; and his beloved dog Marley. 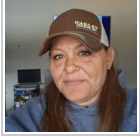
