Katherine Marie 'Katie' Bridges, age 79, of Judsonia, died Thursday, September 21, 2023, at her home in Judsonia. She had been in poor health for the past three months.

Mrs. Bridges was born October 12, 1943, in Martinsville, Indiana, and was the daughter of Ernest Snider and Erna Loehr Snider.
