Mrs. Lena Elizabeth Kennedy, age 89, of Forrest City, died Tuesday at the Crestpark Retirement Inn in Forrest City. She had been in poor health for the past several years.

Mrs. Kennedy was born January 1, 1923, in St. Francis County, and was the daughter of Clarence Schmitt and Eva Bledsoe Schmitt. She lived in St. Francis County most of her life, was retired from Sanyo and the Sewing Factory, and was a member of the St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church.

Mrs. Kennedy married Willie E. Kennedy in 1938, and he preceded her in death in 1977. She is survived by three sons; Clarence Kennedy of Palestine, Dennis Kennedy and Charles Kennedy, both of Forrest City, one daughter, Delia Roberts of Forrest City, one sister, Mary Pokluda of Houston, Texas, eight grandchildren, eight great-grandchildren, and five great-great-grandchildren. She had two daughters; Mary Elizabeth Kennedy and Elizabeth Ann Kennedy, who preceded her in death.
