Leon E. Kidd, age 86, of Forrest City, died Friday, November 8, 2019, at the White County Medical Center in Searcy. He had been in poor health for the past year.

Mr. Kidd was born March 23, 1933, in Milford, Kansas, and was the son of Raymond E. Kidd and Julia DeGraffenreid Kidd. He lived in Forrest City most of his life, graduated from Milford High School, attended Kansas Wesleyan University where he was a sports letterman. He was retired from the United State Postal Service and was an agent for the American General Life Insurance Company, was a Korean Army Veteran and was a member and Deacon of the Landmark Missionary Baptist Church.

Mr. Kidd married Nancy L. Wilson in 1980, and she survives him along with one son, John Lamar Kirk of Forrest City, one daughter, Brenda Sage of New Mexico, one step-son, Harold M.
