



Lewis C.' Tiner

June 8, 1940 - March 26, 2013

Mr. Lewis 'L.C.' Tiner, age 72, of Jonesboro, formerly of Forrest City, died Tuesday at the St. Bernard's Hospital in Jonesboro of an apparent heart attack.
