



## Linda L. Clark Thweatt

August 30, 1946 - July 23, 2021

Linda L. Clark Thweatt, age 74, of Forrest City, died Friday, July 23, 2021, at her daughter's home in Palestine. She had been in poor health for the past three months.

Linda was born August 30, 1946, in Forrest City, and was the daughter of Charles 'Sonny' Clark and Allean Shaw Clark. 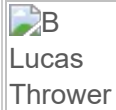
