



Lloyd Allen Nichols

Mr. Lloyd Allen Nichols, age 82, of Forrest City, died Sunday, May 3, 2020, at his home in Forrest City. He had been in poor health for the past month.

Mr. Nichols was born May 5, 1937, in Des Arc, Arkansas, and was the son of Charles Edward Nichols and Minnie Rogers Nichols. He lived in St. Francis County most all of his life, was retired from Airtherm Products after thirty-four years, was a Veteran of the United States Air Force, and was a member of the Emmanuel Baptist Church.
