



## Lloyd Anthony 'Rambo' Renigar

December 11, 1965 - July 20, 2022

Lloyd Anthony 'Rambo' Renigar, age 56, of Forrest City, died Wednesday, July 20, 2022, at the Baptist Hospital in Heber Springs. His death came sudden and unexpected.

Mr. Renigar was born December 11, 1965, in West Memphis, and was the son of Lloyd Calvin Renigar and Doriss Elaine Stokes Renigar. He lived in St. Francis County all of his life, retired as Chief from the Forrest City Fire Department after thirty-three years of service, was chief security for the First National Bank of Eastern Arkansas and Food Giant, was a part time Deputy Sheriff for the St. Francis County Sheriff's Department, was a member of the St. Francis Search and Rescue, the National Firefighters Association, and a founding member of the Arkansas Fallen Firefighters Memorial Association. He was a member of the Oak Hill Church of God.
